Antony Peebles was educated at Westminster School and Trinity College Cambridge. After gaining his MusB he studied piano with Peter Katin and also with Yvonne Lefebure and Jeremy Siepmann.

In 1971 he won the BBC Piano Competition with a unanimous vote from the jury and then, in the following year, he won the Debussy Competition in France.

Since then he has maintained a very busy performing career performing in 131 different countries - the most recent additions to the list were Rwanda, Armenia and Libya.

At home he has played as concerto soloist with the London Symphony, Royal Philharmonic, Halle, City of Birmingham Symphony, Royal Liverpool Philharmonic, BBC Philharmonic, BBC Welsh Symphony, City of London Sinfonia orchestras. He broadcasts on BBC Radio 3.
