The champagne flowed at West Lodge Park Hotel recently at the Taittinger Gourmet Dinner on Friday September 26.

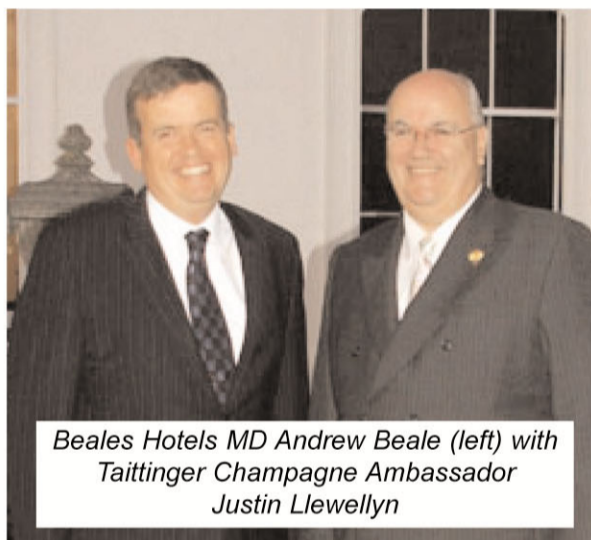
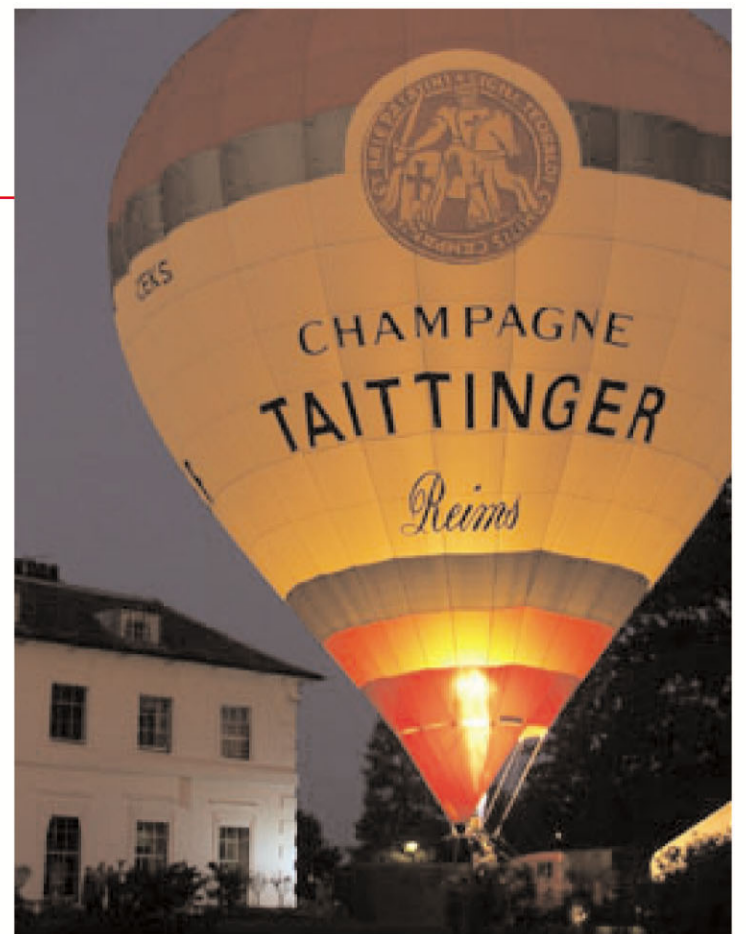
